Palo del Amo Woods Board of Directors Announces Upcoming Elections

We hereby officially announce the upcoming elections for the Board of Directors of Palo del Amo Woods Homeowners Association. Per our bylaws, the term of the Board is one year. Therefore, the current Board will remain in office until the elections have been completed and the new Board is installed. We anticipate completing the election process and installing the new Board by the end of November 2020.

Members of the Board consist of the President, First Vice President, Second Vice President/Newsletter Editor, Secretary, Treasurer, and three (3) Standing Committee Chairs.

In order for you to be eligible to vote in the upcoming elections, you must be a paid member of the Association. Only one ballot per household. Nominations of candidates, as well as self-nominations are welcome. Re-election of current members of the Board of Directors is permitted.

The current Board has appointed a Nominating Committee whose responsibility consists of nominating and interviewing potential candidates for each of the offices, followed by the selected candidates being placed on the official election ballot.

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) TIPS AND AVAILABALE RESOURCES

HOW TO PROTECH YOURSELF AND OTHERS:

1. Wear a mask when leaving your home.

Your mask is meant to protect other people in case you are infected, even if you do not feel sick. The mask is not a substitute for social distancing.

2. Wash your hand often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

It is especially important to wash

- Before eating or preparing food
- Before touching your face
- After using the restroom
- After leaving a public place
- After blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing.
- After handling your mask
- After changing a diaper
- After caring for some sick
- After touching animals or pets

If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of the hands and rub them together until they feel dry.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth without unwashed hands.

3. Avoid close contact.
4. Inside your home, avoid close contact with people who are sick. If possible maintain 6 feet between the person who is sick and other household members.

Outside your home, put 6 feet distance between yourself and people who don't live in your household.

5. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets and sinks. If the surfaces are dirty, clean them with detergent or soap and water prior to disinfection.

6. Monitor your health daily. Watch for COVID-19 symptoms:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Note: This list does not include all possible symptoms

7. Seek emergency medical attention immediately if:

- You have trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face.
- Please call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.
